

Pupils Return to School

Schools are to reopen to pupils. Going back to school will be safe and the teachers and pupils will be happy to see each other again.

Schools have been shut across Wales for more than ten weeks. Schools have been closed to most pupils because of the Coronavirus pandemic. Children of key workers could still attend school. The Welsh Government made the decision to shut schools following advice from the Prime Minister and the Scientific Advisory Group for Emergencies (SAGE)

The Welsh Government have made the decision to open schools again following advice from Scientific Advisors. Schools will open again in Wales on the 29th of June. It is safe to do so and the right time.



Schools will be a bit different. This is to keep everyone safe. Changes can be difficult at first but school staff will be there to help everyone.

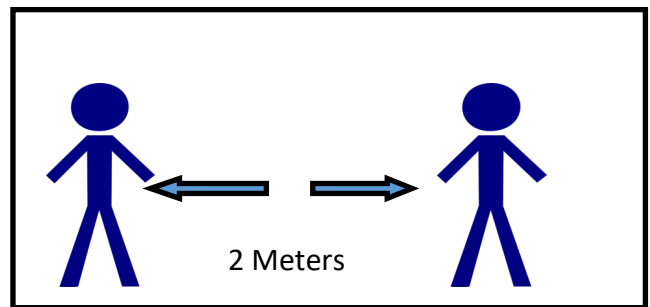
Only one third of the pupils will be in school. This means that there will not be as many pupils in school at the same time.

Pupils may be taught in smaller classes, which may be in a different classroom and with a different teacher. It will be different but it will be okay.

Break times and lunch times may be at different times. Pupils may not be able to sit with their friends but will be able to wave at them from a distance.

Social Distancing

When in school pupils will be expected to social distance from other pupils and staff. This means that individuals are to try to keep 2 meters apart from other people.



Handwashing

Pupils and staff must wash their hands. There will be signs around school to remind everyone to wash their hands often. People must wash their hands for at least 40 seconds.



Pupils and staff must remember to sneeze into a tissue, put the tissue in a bin and wash their hands. Also, cough into their elbow. This is to help everyone keep safe. Staff and pupils must stay at home if they have any symptoms.
